The Candidates should bring the filled application along with all certificates including educational qualification, community and experience certificate / testimonials in original for verification along with one set of self-attested copies while attending test/Interview. Candidates who fail to bring the Original Certificates for written test / Interview will not be considered.
3. In case of more than 30 eligible candidates, a written test will be conducted comprising of multiple choice questions. The level of questions would be of essential qualification prescribed for the post. The candidates will be selected on the basis of their performance in the interview subject to qualifying the skill test wherever applicable.
4. Experience certificate should clearly state the nature of work during the period of employment.
5. No- Objection Certificate from the current employer (for Govt./AB/PSU Servants only)
6. All posts are Contractual for the duration offered. The engagement may be renewed after every specific period of time subject to satisfactory performance and project requirement.
7. The incumbents selected will have no claim for regular appointments under NIRT/ICMR or continuation of his/her services in any other project.
